Lease Extension Update

HSA's Lease with the city of Daytona Beach currently expires in February of 2035. We've asked the city (in writing) to extend the lease an additional 15 years beyond that date, which would take us to February of 2050.

Our most recent update from Parks and Recreation was on April 2 and stated, "Our legal department just sent an email with a couple of questions in regards to your request. Things are still moving forward. We should have more news in the very near future."

We will continue to do our best to keep this process moving forward, and if any "breakthrough" news arrives, we will share it with all members right away.
